System Requirements & Prerequisites

Server Requirements

FaxCore Konica Minolta Connector must be installed on a working and running FaxCore eV5 server. The connector *does not support FaxCore 2007 installations*. Upgrade to FaxCore eV5 prior to installing the connector.

Prerequisites

Configure FaxCore's RenderAgent to use Ghostscript when handling PDF files. The RenderAgent config file is in <u>\\faxcore\renderagent.exe.config</u> file. Open the file with Notepad, look for this setting <add key="PDFRenderingEngine" value=""/> and set the value to "Ghostsript". Save and close the file.

Installing FaxCore Konica Minolta Connector

1. Run *FaxCore_KM_Connector.exe*.

2. Follow the on screen instruction until the "**Destination Folder**" screen and verify the location of your FaxCore root install folder.

Registering FaxCore Connector Applications on the MFP

Run FaxCore Konica Minolta Connector Setup Application

- 1. When the installation process is completed, click on "Start" → "All Programs" → "FaxCore"
- \rightarrow "FaxCore Konica Minolta Connector Setup"



2. Start by entering the **"IP Address"** and the admin **"Password"** of the MFP you want to connect to. You have the option to **"Register Apps"**, **"Manage Apps"** or view the **"MFP Info"**.

- 3. To register applications, select the applications you want to register on the "Register Apps" page, verify the FaxCore server's IP address and enter the "MFP Node/Username" (for FaxCore Browser based applications, this field is used solely as reference to the identity of the registered MFP). However, if you're registering the FaxCore Basic (Native)/FaxCore Pro (Native Type-D) application, this field must match the FaxCore username that the MFP will use to authenticate against FaxCore.
- 4. Toggle the SSL to **SSL ON if** FaxCore is configured to connect with HTTPS only.
- 5. When ready, click on the "**Register**" button.
- 6. You can now access the applications from the MFP. For more information, refer to <u>FaxCore</u> <u>Konica Minolta Connector User Guide</u>.

Additional Configurations

The connector allows you to change default scan settings to achieve optimum output results. To do this, follow the instructions below.

Locate the following file in installdir\FaxCore\web\OAPI40\web.config Open file with Notepad.exe

Search for "ColorType", change its value to "GrayScale" (in "appSettings" and "applicationSettings" section). Save file and close. Restart FXC3.OpenAPI window service.
